Upon my return to NZ, I joined the Rotary Club of Wellington North in 1976 and have since served in leadership positions in Rotary clubs in Manila, Auckland, Washington, DC, and Annapolis and in Districts 9920, 9940 and 7620.

At the international level, I have served on and chaired many Rotary committees across a broad spectrum of Rotary activities and received numerous awards including the Global Alumni Service to Humanity Award, the Service Above Self Award and the Citation for Meritorious Service. As a recent Past RI Director, I have a solid understanding of Rotary's history and its challenges ahead.

Outside of Rotary, I have been actively involved in Outward Bound-related activities in New Zealand and the US and was the Founding Chair of Outward Bound International.
